

NO need to submit your poster to us. Bring your poster during the conference and find your poster-stand.

	Inte the ID] and	ster size: For interactive poster sessions – available poster surface area is restricted to A0 ernational (841mm x 1189mm, or 33.11 inches x 46.81 inches). Authors will print, and will bring to conference venue by themselves, place the poster to the assigned poster stand [marked by paper and be there to present during your presentation time. Do NOT post it to the committee ahead, I we are not responsible to put it on behalf of author(s). ALL presented papers for ICGET15 will be it for IEEE Xplorer.	
		his is the session covering 1 hr each, where presenters will display their posters in the assigned bards and present their works to dedicated Session Chairs for each session.	
		ession Chairs will select some papers for Journals' Special Issues. Therefore, it is recommended that ou prepare well for this.	
	Ple	a may print some materials of your work and distribute to those who are attending your session. ase note that you are NOT allowed to distribute any materials other than your exact paper, which presenting in the session.	
		alti-presenters can attend the IPS and present the paper, and you can use your laptops to show eo and other presentations related to your work.	
	Pus	Push pins will be provided.	
		Poster boards will be numbered. Your poster number will be the number of your Paper ID, as in CMT.	
		our poster is only displayed during your poster session. Please take down your poster at the end of our session. Else, we will have to clean to prepare for next sessions.	
		e Session Chairs will move from one poster to the next consecutively. There are no formal werPoint presentations for interactive poster sessions.	
Some suggestions on developing content for your interactive poster session:  □ Title of the paper and author details at the top.			
		After that mention the <i>originality</i> or <i>contribution</i> of your work in 25 words or less.	
		Then add as you want – covering research objectives, content, methods, flowcharts if any, experimental results and analysis, good points and shortcomings of your work, Conclusion, Future works, key references if required, etc. [you can decide what to keep and how to design!]	
		Use more images/graphics and try to avoid too much text.	
		Point-wise presentation may look better than inserting full sentences, let alone pasting a paragraph.	
		Avoid using UPPER CASE and avoid using more than two types of fonts.	
		Add only the required equations.	
		Do not mention what is evident in usual text book or well-known materials.	
		Keep the size of texts in such a manner that one can read it from a few meters far.
