- Please make sure that you added all authors and affiliations properly in the final submission.
- MUST add 'Contribution—' after the Abstract [as part of the Abstract and as the last sentence] and before Index Term / Keyword as a short 1 sentence about the core contribution of your work [not which author did what].
- Remove all RED colors and rebuttals that you added in the revised submission. Check VERY carefully about the Quality of Images, Tables, Typo / spelling mistakes, grammatical issues, formatting.
- Make sure that all references are according to the IEEE Template.
- Avoid using 'et al.' in the references unless more than 5 authors. On that case add 5 authors then et al. See similar exact instructions. Make sure that you manually edit references [if you use BibTex] for any wrong formatting. No need to add DOI.
- Do NOT add extra authors in your paper. Add exactly what are added in the CMT during the first submission.
- PDF Checker to check the final PDF before submission.
- If a paper has high similarity or plagiarism it may be removed from the conference even after the presentation. IEEE is very strict on plagiarism.

MUST check your PDF by IEEE PDF eXpress, then upload the paper in the CMT!
